A Draught of part of a Track of Land scheate in Gilford Towns ship containing Two huendred and eight weres and the usual allowance of six po dent for roads, Divided off for James Young from a larger Track of Haree hundred and eighty eight weres and the usual accounter of six p. Cont. for Roads, Durveyed for James Jack Nov? 28th 1464 in pursuavel of a warrant from the Hones the Broknetaries.

Bearing Date the second day of July Annotherini 1762,

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this Land day of Leanny 1901,
