

Deed of Survey No 458

In pursuance of a Warrant No 3833 dated 22d April 1793  
 Surveyed 10<sup>th</sup> September 1793 To Isaac Anderson the above  
 described tract of Land situate on the main Branch of  
 Mahoning creek about 4 miles from the mouth of  
 S<sup>d</sup> creek & Adjoining Lands surveyed to William Willink  
 & others and Lands surveyed to Jeremiah Illuy in  
 the late purchase Northumberland County in District  
 No 6 containing two hundred and twenty Acres &  
 allowance of six per cent.
