



A Draught of a tract of land in Greenfield Township Erie County on French creek surveyed the 15th day of September 1801 for John Donaldson by virtue of his Actual Settlement, and Resurveyed the 3^d day of September 1802 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to the said John Donaldson dated the 2^d day of March 1802 containing 576 Acres Allowance &c. It being the same tract of land which was said to have been surveyed on a Warrant dated the 15th day of April 1792 granted to Paul Cox on condition of Actual Settlement and improvement. Whose of Default hath occurred.
