N.B. The warrant on which the above was survey'd is dated the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of November 1750. & granted to James Loughery & Hugh Baxted Vacating a wt. of 25<sup>th</sup> day of March 1738. Granted to Jacob Garrison requiring 150 a.<sup>c</sup>. part thereof to be Retd. for the use of S<sup>r</sup> Loughery & 50 a.<sup>c</sup>. the residue for S<sup>r</sup> Baxted. Baxted's part Retd. into S<sup>r</sup> Secret<sup>y</sup> Office 25<sup>th</sup> February 1756.
