Deed on the main Branch of Big Tobys Creek above the second fork in the last purchased tract No. 4. Containing Nine hundred & ninety acres & the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the eighteenth day of July, 1794
By Warrant to Willem Wilink, Nicolaas Van Stephorst, Pieter Stedemitski, Christiaan Van Eeghem, Hendrick Vollenbroek & Rutger Jan Schimmerpenninck of Amsterdam, No. 4860. Dated the third day of February 1794 for 900 acres.
