



A draught of a Tract of Land situated on the waters of Loyalsock Creek,

November 1<sup>o</sup> 88, for John Ashmead Sen<sup>r</sup> in pursuance of his  
Warrant bearing date the first day of July 1<sup>o</sup> 84. Containing Four  
Hundred & nine acres & one quarter & the allowance of six p cent for Roads &c.
