

A Draught of a Tract of Land Surveyed the 7th day of April 1794, for
 William Wilson, in pursuance of his Warrant for 150 acres of land dated
 the 18th day of May 1792. Situate on the West side of the West Branch of
 Cap'n O'Hara's saw mill run & adjoining the Reserved Tract oppo-
 site the Town of Pittsburg, Called Dover. Containing 150 acres of the
 usual allowance of six feet clear for Roads &c.
