A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Little Britain Township Lancaster County containing 161 acs. & 54 ps and the usual Allowance of Six pr ct. for Roads &c. Surveyed the Seventh Day of August A. D. 1806 for Saml. COPPACK &c. It being part of a Larger Tract of 212 acs. & Allowance.
