

Containing three hundred & two Acres & three quarters besides the usual allowance of six p. cent for Roads & ta. Surveyed the 18th day of May 1775 for William Hodge In pursuance of a warrant dated the 20th day of February 1775. by Chas. Stewart Dep. Sur. To John Lukens Esqr. Surveyr. Genl.
