A Draught of a Tract of Land Called — Situate on the West side of the North East Branch of Susquehanna River oppoite an Island about 4 Miles below the mouth of Tunkannock Creek and adjoining Land Survey'd for John Hammon in the County of Northumberland. Containing two hundred And Eighty two Acres besides the usual allowance of Six & Cent for Roads &c.

Surveyed the 18th Day of November 1774 for Henry Hill. In Pursuance of A Warrant Dated the 17th day of March 1774.
