



A Draught of a Tract of land called— Situate on the head Waters of Wyalosing Creek adjoining land granted to James Coburn in the County of Northumberland, containing three hundred and One Acres and three Quarters of an Acre, besides the usual allowance of six Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the fourteenth day of September 1776 for Joshua Hewes. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August 1774.
