

A Draught of One hundred and twentyfive acres and ninetyfour perches of land with six percent for Roads situate in Greenwood Township (formerly Cumberland now) in Mifflin County which is part of a tract of land surveyed 3<sup>d</sup> May 1782 said to contain 225 $\frac{1}{2}$ <sup>a</sup> now found to contain 224 $\frac{9}{16}$  in pursuance of a warrant to John Brown dated 19<sup>th</sup> February 1755.
