Anno domino 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant granted Barnard Brunor dated the 6<sup>th</sup> day of May Anno domino 1794 situated on the Waters of Hunters fork of Wheeling Creek in Washington County called Newhaven containing two hundred and fifty two Acres and allowance of six Per Centum &c.
