

A Draught of a Tract of Land called Snow Shoe Camp about two Miles Westerly from the Sleeping Place of that name on the Path leading from Chingleclarmouche to the great Island about ten Miles East from Mosshannon Creek adjoining Land of Josiah Matlack & others in the County of Northumberland Containing two hundred & thirty five Acres & three Quarters of the usual Allowance of six P cent. for Roads &c. Surveyed the 11<sup>th</sup> Day of May 1774 for Richard Jones in pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 14<sup>th</sup> Day of May 1773. by
