



A draught of a tract of land situate in Huntington township in the County of York Surveyed the 29th March 1796 by the lines formerly Run by Charles Lukens D.S. for the Heirs of John Brandon deceased. In pursuance of two warrants one dated the 5th February 1754 Granted to George Brandon the other in the name John Brandon Dated the 12 day of July 1762 containing Three hundred and five acres and one hundred and Twenty seven perches and allowance of six acres & Cents for roads &c.
