



A Draught of a Tract of Land called "Amwell" situate on the waters of Tunkhannock near lands surveyed for Jonathan Dickison Sergeant and adjoining land surveyed for W<sup>m</sup> Chambers & others in the County of Northampton containing - Three hundred & forty three acres besides the usual allowance of six perCent for Roads &c<sup>o</sup>.

Surveyed the 23<sup>d</sup> day of November 1774 for David Chambers in pursuance of a warrant dated the 15<sup>th</sup> day of July 1774.
