Note 1st. At the time of surveying the above the warrantee stated that he considered it unimproved, but as a part of it was cleared, about 25 years ago, he was perfectly willing to pay to the Commonwealth, lawful interest on the purchase money.

I am requested by Charles McCoy, and his Attorney to return the above in dispute, as he claims the same by virtue of an improvement, commenced on said Land, by the said McCoy, about 3 years since, and also that he intends entering up a Caveat against the issuing of a Patent to said Humberstone.
