

The above is a draught of a Survey Situate on the North West bank of the Ohio River, made on the 10th. day of September, 1792 in Pursuance of a warrant granted to David Hoge, Jun^r on the 3d. day of April, 1792 call'd "Bacchus Delight," containing 414 $\frac{1}{4}$ acres with allowance for Roads &c.
