

The Draught of a tract of land Situate in Howard township Centre County Containing three hundred and thirty Seven Acres and allowance of Six percent & Surveyed the 10th day of March 1814. in pursuance of a warrant granted to Mordicai Livergood dated the 4th day of February A.D. 1814.

At the time of making the above Survey, Mordical Livergood and family resided on the same, in a two Story log house, Stone Chimney, a small spring house, and about an Acre, or three quarters of an Acre of cleared Land.
