These are to authorize and require you to survey and lay out for our use the quantity of Five Thousand Acres of Land at Brushy Run adjoining an Improvement made by Andrew Bayerly in the County of Cumberland and to make Return thereof into our Secretary's Office for which this shall be your sufficient Warrant Witness John Penn Esq: Lieutenant Governor & Commissioner of Property of the said province who by virtue of certain powers from the said proprietaries hath hereunto set his Hand & caused the Seal of the Land Office to be affixed at Philadelphia this twenty second day of February in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred & sixty nine.
