The afores^d warrt^r & survey made void, Morgan Herbert not complying with the conditions & another warrt^r issued on the 15th of May 1740 to return this survey to Robert Mathews. Returned accordingly the same day 2203/4^{as} & allow. 40.

Upon search in my office & the Secretaries on the 2^d of May 1740 no warrt^r found to have been granted to Robert Mathews, it was survey^d by warrt^r granted to said Herbert dated ye 19th of April 1737 whose right Mathews purchased.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this tenth day of May 1912
