

In pursuance of a warrant dated Feby 13th 1786 was surveyed for George McDowell the above described tract of land containing two hundred & fifty acres and one hundred & thirty three perches with an allowance proportioned to six & cent situate on the waters of Thompsons Run adjoining land of William McIlroy, George Brotherton & others in Pitt township Westmoreland County survey'd May 10th 1786.
