



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Antrim Town-
 ship Cumberland County Containing one hundred and thirty
 seven acres and one hundred and forty five perches and allowed
 surveyed for Teter Loney the Twentieth day of March 1765 in
 consequence of the Honorable Proprietaries Warrant dated at Phila-
 delphia the 28th day of February 1750 -
 Now Washington Township - Franklin County - John Armstrong S.S. -
 Do John Ludens Esq. Surveyor General - 17th June 88.

Note - On Searching for this dft. we found a Retⁿ of 77^{1/2} acres Survt^d in 1751 only
 above wt. of w^{ch} John Horner the present owner was in possession of a
 Copy, which circumstance induced a belief that there was no other Retⁿ
 and said Horner knowing the quantity of land he possessed to be as
 above 137^{1/2} ac obtained a wt. for 60. ac. ~~which he had~~ dated
 the 3^d Octob. 1786 & got Math^w Henderson to Survey & Retⁿ it
 but finding this dft. in the office of S^t Horner is desirous of
 Patenting by it - The Secretary says it may be Ret^d on both
 wt^s viz Loney & Horners by w^{ch} means Horner may have the
 benefit of ye money pd. on the new warrant.
