



The Draught of a tract of land called "Beaver Dam  
situate in Penns Township, Northumberland County  
containing Two hundred and seven acres and thirty  
eight Perches, with the usual allowance of six acres  
per cent for roads &c. Surveyed the 10<sup>th</sup> day of  
May Anno Dom: 1773 in pursuance of a warrant  
from the Honorable the Proprietaries to James  
Armstrong bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 25<sup>th</sup>  
February Anno Domini 1773.
