



A Draft of three tracts of land Situate in Plainfield Township Northampton County containing two hundred nineteen acres 100 perches and the allowance of six p. cent, Surveyed as followeth,

 3. The other tract was surveyed the 10 April 1787 by warrant granted to Philip Achenbach dated the 9th March 1787 containing 47 acres 100 Perches
