



A Draught of Two Tracts of Land one containing Three hundred & ninety three acres & a half Acre the other, one hundred & forty four acres & a half Acre & allowance of six P Cent Situate on the South side the West Branch of Susquehanna formerly in the County of Buck now Northumberland Alloted and Surveyed for Captain John Brady being part of a larger tract Surveyed in the mouth of March & April 1769. for the Office of the first and second Battalion of the Pennsylvania Regt. In pursuance of an Order No 1 dated the 3d Feby 1769.
