



Draft of the Resurvey of a tract of Land Situated in Lamantownship Clinton County originally surveyed pursuant to a Warrant dated December 10th 1829, Granted to Alexander & Zacharias Mc Neal in trust &c. And I find one hundred and Eleven acres and one hundred and fifty five perches and allowance of 6 per acre for roads &c Unincumbered by older Warrants and Surveys, to wit:- David Currey Warrant dated December 9th 1794, Henry Donnel Warrant dated Feby. 6th 1794, Jonathan Cook Warrant dated Sept. 22nd 1794, David Ligget Warrant dated May 2^d 1793, Robert Ritchey Warrant dated Feby. 27th 1794, all of which is Represented by by dotted lines. And the Ritchey Survey of extends South, and interferes with Ligget, thereby covering part of the M^c Neal marked B. and Cook and Donnel are Represented by C & D. The old M^c Neal tract is included within the Red Lines and the David Currey within the Yellow lines, Resurvey November 10th 1860, for John M^c Neal and William Hartung the present owners of the above property.
