

The above is the Draught of a Survey made August 14th, 1828 for William Marks Esq;
in pursuance of a Warrant granted to George Davidson dated 4th April 1797 for one hundred
acres of Land being improved situated in the Moon Township in Allegheny County
now Penn Township in Beaver County. Containing one hundred sixtysix and a half
acres three Rods four inches perches and allow one & six paces for Roads &

Note The land represented by the above Draught has been in a great thrifly
settled till of late years the Lands adjacent to it have been settled.
I am informed by several of the old Settlers within a few miles of it that a
Captain William Richardson formerly owned Land in the neighborhood of
the above Tract and which ob^t cannot correctly inform me and the
Land Title thenceabouts having been so often transaltered and owners names
Changed I am not able at present to state particularly where said Richardson's
Land joined the above. But I know that Arthur Gardner his own
(or Gain) Land adjoining the above and that he had disposed of it to Samuel
Wilson above mentioned as an adjoines
