

In Pursuance of a warrant OCT 4 1834 dated 29th Jan'y 1834 Surveyed the
3rd of the 8th mo. 1834 for William Willinck Nicholas Van Staphorst,
Christiaan Van Eeghen, Pieter Stadnitski Hendrick Vollenhoven and
Rutger Jan Schimmelponnick, the above described tract of land situate
adjoining their other land in Dist Twp 2 in the late purchase in Northumberland
County containing nine hundred and ninety Acres and the Allowance of Six
Percent for Roads &c.
