Obo. 1 is part of a tract surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant to Robert Dunning dated December first 1739. and contains Sixty-five Acres and 21 Perches and allowance.

Obo. 2 is part of a tract surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant to John Dunning dated September eighth 1755 and contains Seventy-seven Acres and ninety-eight Perches and Allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent for Roads &c.
