



Draft of a Tract of Land called Darrocks' Cove situate on the North westerly Branch of Hackawannock in the Counties of Luzerne, adjoining Lands surveyed for James Trimble containing Three hundred and sixteen acres One hundred and fifty six Perches and the usual allowance of Six per Centum for Roads &c surveyed for Thomas Darrock by Charles Stewart Esq<sup>r</sup> late Deputy Surveyor deceased the 4<sup>th</sup> Day of July 1776 in Pursuance of a Warrant bearing date the 29<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1776 certified this 26<sup>th</sup> day of May 1801 by me
