



① Draught of a survey called "Bell-vue situated on ye Ohio River in Alleghany County containing 126 3/4 Acr<sup>s</sup> and ye usual Allowance for Highways &c executed ye 16<sup>th</sup> of August 1891 in Pursuance of an Order for 300 Acr<sup>s</sup> D<sup>r</sup> 618 granted to Thos. Smallman, dated Ap<sup>r</sup>. ye 3<sup>d</sup> 1869.

NOTE, ① Survey was made on this same order on ye 22<sup>nd</sup> June 1886 & rec'd to ye Surv. Genl's Office, of 305 Acr<sup>s</sup> & it is now altered agreeably to this Draught at the instance of W<sup>m</sup> Gugh, Esq.  
Brackenridge Esq<sup>r</sup> who is in part, or entire Proprietor of sd Orders.

The following Remarks made upon the Draft may probably assist in adjusting the Dispute relative to this Survey.

The Survey made on ye Order in ye name of Martin Caughman extends 454 1/2<sup>o</sup> on ye River, and we believe is nearly all Bottom, the average width of the Bottom is 140 1/2<sup>o</sup>.

The Survey made agreeably to the above Draught extends 264 1/2<sup>o</sup> on the River, does not include more than 60 Acr<sup>s</sup> of Bottom, whose average Width does not exceed 40 1/2<sup>o</sup> being only 18 1/2<sup>o</sup> wide at ye upper End.

The Survey next below Martin Caughman's on ye River extends along the Bank 364 P.S. and we believe is nearly all Bottom.
