The said Frantz Wesko by his Deed Roll of the 22d May Anno 1765. Sold and Conveyed his 22d qrt to 60<sup>a</sup> 40 pr. thereof to 22d Shawna Adams and she again, on the 19<sup>d</sup> April 1773. to her Son Simon Adams. The said Frantz 22d he sold the Remainder, containing 8<sup>a</sup> ~~40~~ perches together with his 22d Land to Henry Herty 22d  
In Pa 22d Surveyed for Simon Adams Tract on 22d November Anno 65.  
Now 22d again on the 27<sup>d</sup> Dec 22d by Anno 1783.
