

A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in the Honourable the Proprietaries Mannor of Conestoga in Mannor Township Lancaster County Beginning at a marked White Oak in a Line of Land first Survey'd for Andrew Kauffman and therewith S 14° E 148 Perches to a Post at corner of Land Survey'd for Samuel Nelson therewith S 75° W 178 Perches to a Post and S 15° E 15 Perches to a Post in <sup>Land</sup> Nelson's Line thence Part with Land of Bartholomew Henry Bell and Part with Land of Phillip Uhlwiler S 75° W 91 Perches to a Post thence by a Line of marks obliterated Mannor Land N 75° W 163 Perches to a Post in a Line of Land Survey'd for John Naggy thence Part with the same and part by a Line of marked Trees and with Mannor Land N 75° E 272 Perches to the first mentioned White Oak and place of beginning containing Two hundred and forty four Acres and the Allotment of six Acres to Cent for Roads & Highways.
