A Warrant of Resurvey was granted unto the said Nicholas Shaffer bearing date the 18th Day of June 1788. to rectify the Errors aforesaid. by Virtue of which the said Two Tracts of Land as above described were Resurveyed on the 11th day of July following unto the said Nicholas Shaffer agreeable to the true Lines and bounds thereof, and the Errors therein Rectified.
