



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Upper Saucony Township in the County of Northampton (formerly Bucks) in the State of Pennsylvania, Containing One Hundred & Twenty-Six Acres and 116 perches of Land together with the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads which was formerly Surveyed for Jacob Bachman by Virtue of a Warrant granted to him by the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries. Dated on the ninth Day of March Anno. 1744/5 who by his agreement dated on the 8th day of October Anno. 1748 Sold and Conveyed his Right to the same to Jacob Weaver and after it was sold several times the same was at last Sold and Conveyed to the presnt Possessor Adam Kirtz. Resurveyed on the 1st December Anno. 1757 and now drawn for the said Adam Kirtz on the 26th April Anno. 1782. By Order of the Surveyor General of the 18th April Anno. 1782.
