



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Upper Saucon Township in the County of Northampton (formerly Bucks) in the State of Pennsylvania Containing Thirty one acres and 141 Perches of Land, together with the usual allowance at Six per Cent for Roads which formerly was Surveyed for Henry Alshouse or to Jacob Weaver by virtue of a Warrant granted by the Non ^{the} Proprietaries to the said Henry Alshouse Dated on the 11th October Anno. 1750 who had assigned his Right to the same to the said Jacob Weaver and at last the Right to the same was sold and assigned to the present Possessor Adam Kury Resurveyed on the 30th November Anno. 1757 and now Drawn for the said Adam Kury on the 26th April Anno. 1782 By Order of the Surveyor General dated the 1st April Anno. 1782.
