



A draught of a tract of land situate in Milford Township, Mifflin County appears Surveyed the 21<sup>st</sup> day of July 1767 said to contain 142 3/4 acres No 3261 granted to Wm Irwin granted the 30<sup>th</sup> day of March 1767.

On the 15<sup>th</sup> day of August 1800 an addition was made to the above Survey of 161 acres and 40 perches and the allowance for which is shown to the south of the dotted lines on the above draught from the N.W. cor. of Dennis Christy, pursuant to an order of the board of property in favor of Hugh Hardy dated the 5<sup>th</sup> day of August 1800 - and by virtue of the aforesaid appl<sup>c</sup> in the name of Wm Irwin directed to me for Execution - Land included in the above tract with the addition appears to be 305 3/4 acres and the allowance of 6 p. cent for Roads &c.
