In Consequence of a Certificate granted by the Commissioners appointed to adjust the Claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Pohogania Monongalia and Ohio of which the following is a true copy — We the Commissioners ~~for~~ adjusting the claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongalia Pohogania & Ohio do hereby certify that Andrew Pearce is entitled to four hundred acres of Land in the County of Pohogania situate on the waters of Monongalia to include his settlement made in the year 1769. Given under our Hands at Coles fort the 12 February 1780 & in the fourth Year of the Commonwealth.
