



Situate on the Waters of the middle or Beaver dam Branch of the Frankstown branch of Juniata In Allegany township Huntingdon County and Greenfield Township Bedford County - containing Two Hundred and Thirty six acres & forty perches and allowance - Surveyed for Phineas Buckley on order No 415 dated the 1st day of August 1766.

The purple lines represent the Draught of a tract of Land Surveyed for Thomas Blair on Warrant dated the 16th day of January 1790 - This tract interferes One Hundred and fifty nine acres and one hundred and fourteen perches with the Phineas Buckley Survey - Thomas Blair conveyed to John Blair Esq and Alexander Blair the present owners.

No 1 represented by dotted lines is the draught of a tract of Land Surveyed for William Forsythe on order No 402 dated the 1st day of August 1766 - This tract interferes one Hundred and Eighty six and one fourth acres with the Phineas Buckley Survey - William Forsythe conveyed to John Baynton Samuel Wharton & George Morgan from whom the same descended to Michael F. Simpson who conveyed to Thomas Blair who devised to John Blair & Alexander Blair the present owners.

No 2 represented by dotted lines is part of the draught of a tract of Land Surveyed for Solomon Singer on order No 403 dated the 1st day of August 1766 - this tract Interferes Seventeen acres and one hundred perches with the Phineas Bond Survey - Solomon Singer conveyed to John Baynton Samuel Wharton & George Morgan from whom the same descended to Michael F. Simpson who conveyed to Francis Smith the present owner.

No 3 represented by dotted lines is part of the draft of a tract of Land Surveyed for Charles Smith on order No 21 dated the 1st day of August 1766 - This tract interferes Eleven Acres and one hundred and thirty six perches with the Phineas Buckley Survey - Charles Smith conveyed to Dr William Smith who devised to Charles Smith who conveyed to Joseph More the present owner.

No 4 represented by dotted lines is part of the draft of a tract of Land Surveyed for Phineas Smith on order No 3647 dated the 8th day of May 1767 - This tract interferes Seven acres and one hundred and seventeen perches with the Phineas Buckley Survey - Phineas Smith conveyed to Dr William Smith who devised to Charles Smith who conveyed to Joseph More the Present owner.
