York County Surveyed the 24th day of the 12th Month 1771 In pursuance of a Warrant
Dated the 17th day of August 1749 and including that part of a Survey of 56^a made by John
Churchman on Warrant dated the 10th Day of March 1743 which is now found to be
in Pennsylvania Protracted from the field Works of William Matthews late Deputy Surveyor.

N.B. James Steel claimed a part of this land by warrant dated the 1st of March 1749 but
William Read the present owner having purchased said warrant requested me to note it on Return.
