Forty one perches & allor; Examined in part 18^d June 1818 at the request of Mr. Brisbin In pursuance of a warrant in the name of James McCalley, ^{Dated 5^d January 1797 and} put into my hands 8^d June 1818 by said Brisbin and found to interfere with a Survey which appears to be made for Dorcas Buchanan 27^d Decr 1771 on Order No 1806 dated 14^d Novr 1766 as above laid down; Examined in part & corrected 28^d January 1804, and appears to contain three hundred seven acres. one hundred fourteen perches and the usual allor of six per cent for Roads &c; clear of interference &c.
