Containing 35  $\frac{1}{2}$  & Allowance &c Surveyed (According to the Old lines & Corners &c) for Calvin Cooper By Virtue of a Warrant Dated the 24<sup>th</sup> Day of August 1751. The Warrant calls only one Tract but was found in the Surveying to be in Two Tracts
