



A Draught of a Piece of Land Situate in Paradise Township in the County of York.  
Containing 134 ac 8 1/4 perches & allowance &c part of 17 4 1/2 ac & allowance &c which was  
recently surveyed on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of March 1793 by Henry Danner D.S. under John Forsythe  
D.S. in pursuance of a Warrant for 100<sup>£</sup> granted to Jacob Neave Bearing date the 26<sup>th</sup>  
day of August 1752. Resurveyed & divided off from the said larger Tract of Land on  
the 26<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1837 for John Rohl, the present owner, who requested me  
to make return of the same for Confirmation.
