



Situate in Hanover Township in the County of York formerly part of Lancaster County on little Conewago - Containing in the whole as above set forth 402  $\frac{1}{2}$  acres & 5 perches and allowance. Originally Surveyed by Thomas Cookson late D.S. on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of April Anno Domini 1746. In pursuance of a Warrant for 100  $\frac{1}{2}$  ac granted to Henry Wissler bearing date the 30<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1745. Resurveyed nearly by the old lines in pursuance of the aforesaid Warrant at two different times to wit on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of April and on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of July Anno Domini 1809. — I further Beg leave to State that the part where this \* Mark is placed Represents the Land in dispute between Peter Kreps & Henry DeWalt containing 14  $\frac{1}{2}$  acres & allowance.
