



A Draft of A tract of Land situate on the Beaver dam Branch of the Frankstown branch of Juniata partly in Greenfield Township Bedford County and Allegany Township Huntington County - containing three hundred and fifty four and one fourth acres and Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads & so Surveyed for William Forsythe the \_\_\_ day of \_\_\_ on order N<sup>o</sup> 402 dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of August 1766

N.B. The dotted lines represent part of a draft of a tract of Land Surveyed for Thomas Blair on Warrant dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of January 1790 - this tract interferes Three Hundred and fourteen acres and one Hundred and sixty three perches with the William Forsythe Survey - William Forsythe conveyed to John Baynton, Samuel Wharton and George Morgan who conveyed to Michael F. Simpson who conveyed to Thomas Blair who obtained the aforesaid Warrant and then conveyed to John Blair Esqr the present owner
