

The above is the Draught of a Tract of Land in Possession of James Wilson Situate on Octoraro Creek in Little Britain Township Lancaster County Containing in the whole 2.57 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres the allowance of 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ per cent. 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ thereof at C was Survey'd for Andrew McDowell in Pursuance of a Warrant bearing Date the 1st day of February 1743 - 138 $\frac{1}{2}$ as above, Survey'd for y^c said J^r Wilson By warrant in his own Name, & also A & B 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ & 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ Survey'd for him the 3rd day of the 12th mo. 1762 by a latter Warrant bearing Date the 6th of June 1759.
