



Resurvey the above described two tracts, or pieces of land situated in Heidelberg Township, Lebanon County, one of them containing 70 acres & allow and the other of them containing 207 acres & 53 perches of land. In pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property bearing date the 1st day of December 1835 Granted to Saml. Oberly for the use of the heirs of Christian Zrally deceased formerly surveyed on March the 10th day of May 1749. Granted to Christian Zrally -- The above tract of land representing the dotted lines - has interfered on a tract of 207 acres of land & also on a tract of land of Charles T. Alexander Stedman.

Note, the red lines representing C. Zrally's land & the yellow lines part of C. T. Stedman's land & therefore that tract of the dotted lines is an erroneous Survey & encroaches upon the rights of other owners. Resurvey the 25th day of April 1836 & find the same as above represented.
