



The above Draught represents an Island (called "Middle Island") in the Susquehanna river, in Manor township, Lancaster county. Containing One acre and twenty six perches, strictly measured, lying outside of the Main Conestoga Island, and about a fourth of a mile from the Lancaster County shore. — Surveyed October 16<sup>th</sup> 1860, in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 6<sup>th</sup> day of September 1859, granted to James Hudtson
