



In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 8<sup>th</sup> day of September 1766 - Surveyed the 2<sup>d</sup> day of October 1767 for William Henry the above described Tract of Land Situate on the South West Branch of Brush Creek in the County of Cumberland called the Plum Tree Bottom containing one hundred and thirty seven acres and a quarter and the usual allowance of six acres per lot for Roads &c.
